Summary of Electric Rate Schedules

Effective Date January 1, 2013

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

Applicability:

The Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) shall be applied to all members receiving electric service under any rate schedule of the Cooperative where kilowatt-hour energy is used.

Power Cost Amount:

The Power Cost Amount shall be computed based on actual purchased power and transmission billings divided by total kilowatt hours purchased for the month. The resultant cost shall be rounded to the nearest \$0.00001 per kilowatt hour.

Calculation of Power Cost Adjustment:

The PCA charge shall equal the Power Cost Amount less the base cost of \$0.06650 per kilowatt-hour multiplied by total kilowatt-hours purchased for the month, and then divided by total kilowatt-hours sold for the month. The resultant charge shall be applied to all kilowatt hours sold on members' bills for the month.

For the purposed of calculating the Power Cost Adjustment, the following formula shall be used:

$$PCA = (A/B - C) \times B/D$$

PCA = Power Cost Adjustment factor in cents per kilowatt-hour rounded to four decimal places applied on a per kilowatt-hour basis to all metered and unmetered sales of electricity.

A = Cost of purchased power and transmission charges in dollars for the month.

B = Total kilowatt-hours purchased and billed to the Cooperative by wholesale power suppliers during the month.

C = Base cost of power, which equals the average cost of power purchased for the test year period. This figure remains constant in each subsequent monthly calculation at \$0.06650 per kilowatt-hour until otherwise changed by the Cooperative.

D = Total kilowatt-hours sold during the month.

Frequency of Computation:

The power cost adjustment amount will be calculated and applied no more frequently than once each month.

Miscellaneous Service Fees

Temporary Service Minimum -\$25 Disconnection Charge - \$25 Returned Check Charge - \$10 Reconnection charge - \$40 Collection Charge - \$25 Meter Test Fee - \$10

Penalty

When the bill becomes delinquent, a 10% penalty will be added to the bill.
